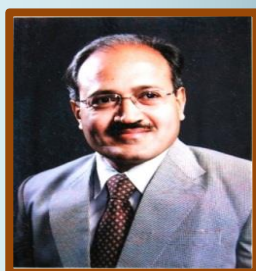

Vachan Prerna Din Celebrated at College

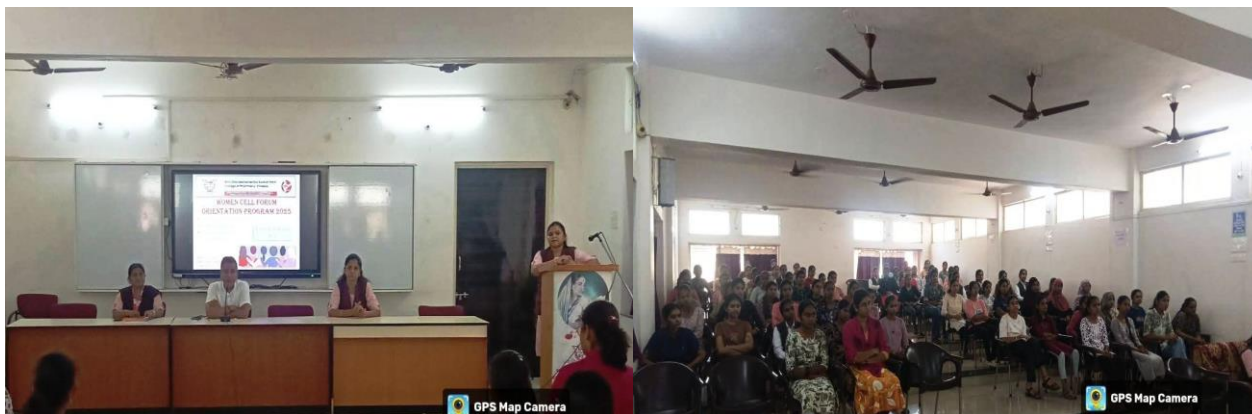

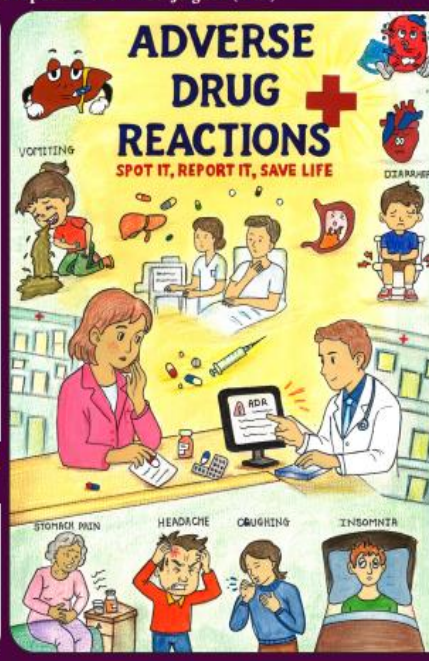
