1. Excel in Professional career & / higher education by acquiring knowledge in Pharmacy principles.
2. Analyze health problems & find out appropriate solution that are technically sound, economically feasible & socially acceptabl.
3. Exhibit professionalism, ethical attitude, communication skills, team work in their profession & adapt to current trends by engaging in lifelong learning.

### ***Programme Outcome (PO)***

The Programme outcomes are the skill and knowledge which the students have at the time of graduation. The outcomes essentially indicate what a student can do from subject-wise knowledge acquired during the programme. The outcome may be programming specific within broad categories given in the following. Generally, the Pharmacy program must demonstrate their graduates have following capabilities.

  5. An ability to develop confidene for self education and ability for long learning.
  6. An ability to show the understanding of impact of Pharmaceutical sciences on the society and also will be aware of modern issues.
  7. An ability to participate and succeed in competitive examination.
  8. An ability to demonstrate knowledge of professional and ethical responsibilities as per Pharmaceutical jurisprudence.
  9. An ability to communicate effectively in both verbal and written form.
  10. An ability to demonstrate skills to use modern Pharmaceutical tools, software and equipment to analyze & solve problems.
  11. An ability to understand knowledge in Research & development in all disciplines of Pharmaceutical sciences.
